

## **HOME – SCHOOL AGREEMENT**

## In educating and caring for your child, Little Heath School will:

- provide a fulfilling and challenging education;
- maintain a vibrant and successful environment for learning;

- · set homework regularly using Show My Homework;
- communicate regularly with parents about pupils' progress;
- provide a range of enrichment activities;
- take prompt action when we are worried about attendance and punctuality;
- give you early warning, via the tutor, classroom teacher, Head of Department or Head of Year, of difficulties with your child's work, progress, behavior, well-being or relationships.

## As a parent / carer of a student at Little Heath School, I will:

- take an active interest in my child's education;
- encourage my child to do his / her best;
- ensure that my child has a suitable school bag and brings the correct equipment for all lessons including P.E. to school each day, including blue or black pens, pencils, ruler, rubber, sharpener, geometry set, scientific calculator and colouring pencils;
- support my child with homework, including regularly accessing Show My Homework;
- actively support the school's approach to discipline and standards;
- accept responsibility for my child's behaviour;
- ensure that my child wears the correct school uniform as outlined in the school uniform policy;
- ensure that my child attends school in accordance with the school's policy and is punctual;
- contact the school at an early stage in the event of any concerns or problems, including well-being, safety and medical;
- encourage my child to take pride in his / her school and play a full part in school life;
- attend parents' evenings and other school events;
- talk to my child about the internet sites that they use and report any concerns via the CEOPs button or the SMILE email address (smile@littleheath.org.uk) if I am concerned about my child's well-being;
- keep the school informed/updated on changes to my contact details;
- support my child to travel safely to school, including maintaining his / her bike and encouraging him / her to follow the school's recommendation that pupils wear a safety helmet.
